Though not required, in support of our festival theme, something blueberry or blue (i.e. balloons, crepe, table covers, vendor attire) would be appreciated as part of the décor of each booth. Vendor set-up is no earlier than 7 a.m., no breakdowns prior to 4 p.m. **With no exceptions, all vendors must be in place and all vehicles removed to proper parking areas by 8:30 a.m.**
